## OUR SANSTHA

Janata Shikshan Sanstha, Wai has a very glorious tradition of imparting quality education. The motto of the Sanstha is "To light up the paths, indeed have we come." The Sanstha has chosen as a symbol of its ideals and aspirations the resplendent Sun that dispels the darkness of ignorance and fills the entire humanity with the light of knowledge. The Vision of the Sanstha is "To provide quality education to the students in order to make them competent and self-reliant in every walk of life" and the Mission is "Education for all round development of the students."

"Janata Mahavidyalaya Samiti" was constituted under the leadership of Deshbhakta Kisan Mahadeo alias Abasaheb Veer, a veteran Freedom Fighter, on 16th July 1961 to establish a college in Wai to impart quality education to the students residing in the remote corners of Wai, Koregoan, Khandala, Mahabaleshwar and Jaoli Tehsils of Satara district. As there was no registered society to establish the college, the responsibility of running "Arts and Commerce College, Wai" had initially been given to Pradnya Pathshala Mandal, Wai headed by Tarkateertha Laxmanshastri Joshi, a renowned Sanskrit Scholar. The college commenced in 1962. Janata Shikshan Sanstha was duly registered on 12th July 1967 with the Registrar of Societies under the Societies Act 1960 and with Assistant Charity Commissioner under Bombay Public Trust Act 1960. The college was soon officially transferred from Pradnya Pathshala Mandal, Wai to Janata Shikshan Sanstha, Wai on 1st April 1968.

Although the college made a humble beginning with only undergraduate Arts and Commerce education, Dr. Appasaheb Pawar, the then Vice-Chancellor of Shivaji University, Kolhapur, gave permission and inaugurated the M. Com. Classes on 4 July 1969. In 1973, the postgraduate classes of Marathi and English were added. The UG classes of the college got the permanent affiliation to Shivaji University, Kolhapur in 1982. The same year Science Faculty was started in the college.

After the sudden demise of founder of the college Kisan Veer in 1979, the college was renamed after his name as "Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya, Wai" in order to commemorate the founder President's remarkable contribution to the establishment and development of the college.

Hon. Shri. Prataprao Bhosale became the President and Late Laxmanrao Jadhav-Patil, the Vice President of the Sanstha. Through their personal initiatives, both raised donations to construct the Science Building consisting of spacious and well-equipped Science laboratories, classrooms and chambers of the teaching faculty.

In 1994, Museum and Green House were constructed through the UGC grants. The Science faculty and the postgraduate programs in Marathi, English and Commerce got permanent affiliation from Shivaji University, Kolhapur in 2001.

In 2012, the Management started M. Sc. Organic Chemistry taking into consideration the demand from the students and the requirement of industry during this era of globalization. With the help of the grants from the UGC, the Management also constructed Women's Hostel and Indoor Sports Hall.

The College Magazine "KRISHNAI", which provides our students a platform for making their imaginative and informative contributions, has won different individual prizes in the magazine competitions organized at the university level.

Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya imparts education in Arts, Commerce and Science faculties along with a degree program in Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA). Our NCC cadets have attended RD Parade and our cadets have received awards and recognition at the State and National levels. The NCC and NSS units have conducted extension activities in the form of Blood donation Camps, Tree Plantation, Literacy Mission, AIDS Awareness, Voter's Awareness, Pulse Polio Vaccination, Nirmal Gram, etc. Our sports persons have played and won medals at the Zonal, Inter Zonal, University, Inter University, State, National and International levels.

In 1962, the strength of the college was only 80. At present, it is more than six thousand. The growth of the college is not only quantitative but also highly qualitative. Our students have excelled in the academic, cultural, sports, NSS and NCC fields at the university, state, national and, sometimes, international levels. Many of our students have occupied good positions in administration, industry, banking, research, and corporate world. The college was accredited in 2004, reaccredited in 2013, assessed for Third Cycle in 2018 and Forth Cycle in 2025 by National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore, with B++ Grade.

During the last sixty-four years, the Management has taken steps to introduce such programs as M.A. (English, Marathi, Hindi & Economics), Science Faculty, Study Centre Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nashik, B.C.A., M.Sc. (Organic Chemistry), Competitive Examination Centre, etc. The college has also developed such educational facilities as huge playground, Students Co-operative Store, Parking, Canteen, Women's Hostel, Indoor Sports Hall, Wrestling Complex, etc. To realise the vision of Hon. Prataprao Bhosale, the Management has shown a great sense of social commitment by constructing "Jai Kisan Boys Hostel" with necessary facilities of free lodging/boarding/uniforms/medical care for the sons of bereaved families affected due to the suicidal deaths of farmers in rural Maharashtra. All the stakeholders of the college have provided financial assistance in the construction of this hostel.

At present, Hon. Madandada Bhosale is the President and Hon. Shankarrao Gadhave, the Vice President of the Sanstha. Under the dynamic leadership of Hon. Madandada, the Management is introducing Skill Development Courses as invisioned in NEP 2020.

## OUR COLLEGE

Janata Shikshan Sanstha's Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya, Wai, is one of the best rural colleges affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur. It was established by Shri. Kisan Veer, a veteran freedom fighter. Initially, "Arts and Commerce College, Wai" had been run by Pradnya Pathshala Mandal, Wai headed by Tarkateertha Laxmanshastri Joshi. The college made a humble beginning with only 80 students in 1962.

Dr. Appasaheb Pawar, the then Vice-Chancellor of Shivaji University, Kolhapur gave approval and inaugurated the M. Com. Classes on 4 July 1969. In 1973, the postgraduate classes of Marathi and English were added. The UG classes of the college got the permanent affiliation to Shivaji University, Kolhapur in 1982. The same year, the Science Faculty was started in the college.

After the sudden demise of Abasaheb Veer, Hon. Shri. Prataprao Bhosale became the President of the Sanstha. Through his personal initiative, he raised donations to construct the Science Building consisting of spacious and well-equipped Science laboratories, big classrooms and chambers of the teaching faculty. In 1994, Museum and Green House were constructed through the UGC grants. The Science faculty and the postgraduate programs in Marathi, English and Commerce got permanent affiliation from the Shivaji University, Kolhapur in 2001.

Recently, in 2012, the Management started M.Sc. Organic Chemistry taking into consideration the requirement of industry during this era of globalization. With the help of the grants from the UGC, the Management has constructed Women's Hostel and Indoor Sports hall. Our Management has shown a great sense of social commitment by constructing a noble project of Boys Hostel for the students belonging to the families of the farmers who have committed suicides. This project was funded by the principal, the teaching & non-teaching staff and the alumni of the college.

The College Magazine "**KRISHNAI**", which provides our students a platform for making



their imaginative and informative contributions, has won different individual prizes in the magazine competitions organized at the university level.

Our sports persons have played and won medals at the Zonal, Inter Zonal, University, Inter University, State, National and International levels. The college was accredited in 2004, reaccredited in 2013, assessed for Third Cycle in 2018 and Forth Cycle in 2025 by National Assessment and Accreditation Council, Bangalore, with B++ Grade. It has also a Distance Education Centre affiliated to Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nasik with the student strength about 2000 students.

Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya imparts education in Arts, Commerce and Science faculties along with a degree program in Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA). Our NCC Unit is vibrant and our cadets have received awards and recognition at the State and National levels. NSS unit has conducted extension activities in the form of Blood donation Camps, Tree Plantation, Literacy Mission, AIDS awareness, Voters awareness, Pulse Polio, Nirmal Gram, etc.

**IX. ADMISSION RULES, REFUND OF FEES AND ELIGIBILITY**

**Preamble**

- a) In accordance with the provisions of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act 2016, the following rules shall be called the Admission Rules to be applicable to the non-professional under-graduate and post- graduate courses in the college.
- b) The admission rules for professional courses shall be as prescribed by the State Government from time to time. These rules have come into force from the Academic Year 2019-20 onward.

**Undergraduate Courses:**

**A.R.1** Admissions to non-professional undergraduates shall be strictly based on:

- a) Eligibility criteria as prescribed by the University from time to time.
- b) Reservation rules as prescribed by the State Government from time to time and adopted by the University.
- c) Merit, as measured by the marks scored in the qualifying previous examination.

**A.R.2** The total intake capacity at the first point of the admission to the Senior College shall be divided as 80 per cent for the attached Junior College and 20 per cent for other Junior Colleges. However, in both cases the basic rules of merit, reservation & eligibility shall be applied. If 20 per cent quota remains unutilized, students from the attached junior college shall be admitted from the waiting list. The merit of the students from other Junior Colleges shall not be less than the merit of the last student admitted from the attached Junior College. In case, 80 per cent quota for the attached Junior College remains unutilized, the College shall have the right to admit students from other Junior Colleges subject to the general rules given above.

**A.R.3** In view of the problem of drop out, the additional 10 per cent of the sanctioned intake capacity may be admitted in the college subject to the general rules of the admission given above.

**A.R.4** In case of admissions to the second and third year of the integrated degree course, preference will be given to the students of the same college.

**A.R.5** There shall be an Admission Committee for the proper monitoring of admissions. After preparing the merit list, the merit list along with the waiting list shall be displayed on the college notice board/website for the information of the students.

**A.R.6** Husband/wife/son/daughter and brother/sister of both the teaching and non-teaching employees (on probation or confirmed) will be given admissions to the courses within a limit of 3 per cent of the total intake capacity subject to intra group merit considerations.

**A.R.7** In case of physically challenged students seeking admission to the first year of the integrated degree course the Admission Committee may use its discretion subject to the fulfillment of other conditions of admission.

**A.R.8** The foreign students shall be admitted to any course in the college on production of provisional eligibility certificate from the University.

**A.R.9** Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Fees and Non-Retention of Original Certificates (As per UGC Notification October 2018)

Cancellation of admission and refund of fees shall be as under:

- 1) All Deposits such as Caution Money, Library Deposit, Laboratory Deposit etc. shall be refundable subject to such deductions as may be necessary on account of any damage to the property of the institution concerned such as breakages to laboratory equipment, loss of library books etc. for which a student may be responsible.
- 2) If a student chooses to withdraw his/her admission in which he/she is enrolled the college will follow the following five tier system for refund of the fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received
1	100 %	15 days or more before formally-notified last date of admission
2	90 %	Less than 15 days before formally-notified last date of admission
3	80 %	15 days or before formally-notified last date of admission
4	50 %	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission
5	00 %	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

The college will refund fees to eligible students within fifteen days from the date of receiving a written application form.

**3) Verification and non-retention of student's Academic and Personal Certificates:**

- Students should not submit their original academic and personal certificates like Mark-sheets, Cast Certificates and other such documents at the time of submitting their admission forms, but the submission of self-attested copies thereof will be mandatory.
- The college will physically verify original documents at the time of admission of the

students in their presence and return them immediately after satisfying about their authenticity. The self-attested copies of the required documents will be kept for the official record.

- The self-attested certificates of the students shall be held valid and by the college for all purposes and administrative requirements and should there be a need for physical verification at any time during the course of the program of study, such verification shall be undertaken and the original certificates thus used for verification shall be returned immediately to the students concerned.
- Taking the certificates into institutional custody under any circumstance or pretext is strictly prohibited.
- In case of any suspicion over the authenticity or genuineness of a certificate, reference may be made to the University or the Board which issues the certificate to the student and the admission will be subjected to the authentication, but original certificate shall not be retained by the college under any circumstance.

**A.R.10** At Part-1,2 and 3 levels, efforts are by the college to ensure a fair distribution of admissions to different special subjects.

**A.R.11** The admissions are completely governed by the rules and regulations made by the University from time to time. A copy of such rules and regulations will be displayed on the notice board and website of the college during the period of admission.

**A.R.12** Rules and regulations regarding admission fees, tuition fees, and various other fees charged by the colleges at under-graduate level shall be governed by the provisions of ordinance as prescribed by the University from time to time. Eligibility: HSC or any equivalent examination passed student is eligible for admission to the first year degree course (B.A./B.Com./B.Sc)

#### Admission Procedure:

- 1) Those students who seek admission for B, A, /B. Com/B.Sc./M.A./M. Com Part-I Courses must open their ABC accounts (Academic Bank of Credits) on Digi Locker & submit their IDs to the college office at the time of admission.
- 2) Only Active Email ID and Active / valid mobile numbers must be used for registration and at the time for admission form submission.
- 3) **One student with his/her one Email ID & active/valid mobile number can submit only one admission form for the selected class/faculty. If not so, your admission form will lead to rejection.**
- 4) Your Active mobile number and valid email ID will be used by college authority for sending instructions for online video lectures and online attendance.
- 5) Notification regarding online admission will be given separately on the college website [www.kvmwai.edu.in](http://www.kvmwai.edu.in)
- 6) **It is mandatory to all the students to subscribe the following YouTube Channel Link and join Facebook Page of Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya at the time of their admissions otherwise their admissions will be led to cancellation:**

## Standard Operating Process (SOP) for the Admission Process in the College- As per the National Education Policy 2020:

### No. The following facilities will be available to students:

- 1 Students will have to choose 1 Major and 1 Minor subject in the second year out of the three subjects taken in the first year of the degree course in all faculties.
- 2 Only the major and minor subjects chosen in the second year will remain mandatory as major and minor in the third year.
- 3 Open Elective (OE) is to be chosen by students of faculties other than the faculty to which it belongs. For example, OE prepared by the Faculty of Commerce and Management cannot be taken by students of the B. Com course of the same faculty. However, students of the Faculty of Humanities, Faculty of Science and Technology and Faculty of Interdisciplinary Studies can select it.
- 4 OE Paper 1 to OE Paper 5 are not mandatory to be of the same subject. They can be of different subjects.
- 5 SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) Paper 1 to SEC (Skill Enhancement Course) Paper 4 can be selected from the same or different subjects
- 6 VEC (Value Education Course) Subjects will be as per the rules issued by the Board of Studies
- 7 AEC (Ability Enhancement Course) will be English Compulsory paper.
- 8 Indian Knowledge System (IKS) will be Generic for all first-year students. However, IKS will be Major Specific for Part 2.
- 9 Students of CC (CO-Curricular Course) are required to complete 60 hours for the course.
- 10 Action should be taken as per the rules issued by the university regarding CEP (Community Engagement Program), CC (Co-curricular Course), FP (Field Project) and RP (Research Project). It is necessary to complete 60 hours of work of CEP and it is mandatory for the students to prepare a Diary and Project Report of the work done.
- 11 FP (Field Project), CEP, OJT, RP will be related to the Major subject.
- 12 OJT (On Job Training/Internship/Apprenticeship) will be done as per the policy implemented by Shivaji University.
- 13 A Skill Assessment Board should be established as per NEP Regulation 2.0 of the University to assess Skill Enhancement Courses.
- 14 After completing one year of the Degree Course, one can exit by taking UG Certificate. After the second year of the Degree Course, one can exit by taking UG Diploma. These students will have to complete a four-credit professional course during the summer vacation as per National Credit Framework (NCF).
- 15 After the third year of the Degree Course, a student can exit by taking UG Degree.
- 16 It is mandatory to have 7.5 CGPA or 75% marks to get admission in the fourth year of the Degree Course (Honours with Research).
- 17 After completing the fourth year, an Honours Degree can be obtained and students who have sought admission in a Research Degree can get Honours with Research Degree after the fourth year.
- 18 A student who has completed a Four-year Degree can get direct admission in the second year of the Postgraduate Degree.
- 19 Students who have completed a Three-year Degree can seek admission in the first year of a Postgraduate Degree.
- 20 If a student wants to exit after completing the first year of a Postgraduate Degree, s/he will have to complete a four-credit Professional Study or Skill Development Study during the summer vacation. After that, s/he can get a Post Graduate Diploma.
- 21 After completing the second year of a Postgraduate Degree, a student can get a Postgraduate Degree.

**Note:** For more information in this regard, you will have to refer to NEP Regulation 2.0 issued by Shivaji University, Kolhapur.
