# Janata Shikshan Sanstha's KISAN VEER MAHAVIDYALAYA, WAI, DIST. SATARA \_\_\_\_\_Department of Political Science

Report on the One Day Study Tour at Naneghat & Shivneri 5<sup>th</sup> Day of October, 2019

Department of History, Political Science and Geography jointly organized one day study tour on the 5th day of October, 2019. It covered the ancient site *Nana Pass* (Nane ghat) and fort of *Shivneri*, the birth place of Chh. Shivaji Maharaj. There were 43 students participated in this expedition. Dr. J. V. Kathare, Head Department of History, Dr. Kiran Sonttake, Department of Geography and Prof. Rajendra Jaykar participated as representatives of the respective departments.


Naneghat is a mountain pass in the Western Ghats range, 32 kms from Junnar in Pune district. During the region of the Satavahana, the pass was extensively used as a trade route between Kalyan and Junnar. Most of the students were curious to witness this ancient gateway of Konkan. The distance between Wai and Naneghat is near about 211 kms. We reached the foothill of the Naneghat at 11:00 am by MSRTC Bus via Junnar. Junnar, with 184 caves at the head of Nanaghat, had one of the largest Buddhist establishments where Satavahana royalty sculpted their portraits and inscribed their first epigraphs. This ghat must have been excavated under the royal patronage. After breakfast, we started climbing the site by walk at 11:30 am. We reached Naneghat at 12:00 noon.


Dr. J. V. Kathare narrated the history of the site. The term Nanaghat is said to denote a site where money transactions took place on the grounds that nana, the important coin device of the Kusanas, had come to be used in a general sense for money. This is corroborated by the existence of a massive jar at the entrence of the pass, used for collecting toll money. Similarly two habitation sites at the foot of the ghat, known as Pradhanapada (main centre) and Vaisaghara (traders' site), are seen as indicators of the presence of traders on this route. In the absence of concrete evidence that would trace the antiquity of these names to the Satavahana period, it would be difficult to attribute any importance to them. There is no denying, however, that Nanaghat would have been used for the transportation of commodities and goods from the ancient ports of Kalyan and Sopara further inland or as an outlet for the fertile tract around Junnar. After short discussion of around half an hour we started journey towards the fort of

Shivneri, at 01.15 pm. where the birth of Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj took place. We reached Shivneri at 02.00 pm. As there is a well maintained road up to the stapes of the forts and all steps are also easy to climb. We experienced the fort has seven doors. There is a huge statue of Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj in front of the main entrance to the fort. Strong walls and sheer rock cliffs on three sides ensured Shivneri was well protected.

As we enter in the *Shivneri* fort there was a small garden inside and we took some rest there. Then we started moving towards the two-storey structure where Chh. Shivaji Maharaj was born. From The top of the building we observed magnificent views of the surrounding landscape. Then, we moved to *Shivai Temple* and *Badami Talav*. After observing all of these places, we again came back towards the garden area and completed our lunch. As it was almost evening so we leave from Shivneri fort. We started journey towards Wai and reached our destination at 10.00 pm. Our visit to ancient Naneghat and shivneri fort was really a nice experience.
