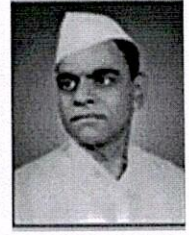

Botany is very interesting science. The botanical excursion always increases the knowledge about the nature in this visit Mrs. Bhimashankar Shukla has provided nice and valuable information about medicinal plant and herbal products. He has given some information like how to prepare herbal products value of medicinal plant etc.to the students.

Product made from botanical or plants that are used to treats diseases or to maintain health are called herbal products or phytomedicines. A product made from plants and used for internal used called herbal suppliant.

Many prescription drugs and over the counter medicines are also made from plant products but these products only purified ingredients. Herbal supplement may contain entire plants or plant parts.

Herbal supplements come in all forms dried, chopped, powered, capsule or liquid and can be used in various ways including

- 1.Swallowed as pills, powders or tinctures
- 2.Brewed as tea
- 3.Applied to the skin as gels, lotions or creams
4. Added to bath water.



List of Plants: Herbal products are particularly preferred since they are eco-friendly and would not provide allergic reactions to the skin and the body.

Some of important herbs and medicinal plants are required for making herbal products.
