## History Students Forum organized Study Tour October 25, 2018

A one day Study tour for the Students of the Department, was organized on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2018. It covered the Early Buddhist Cave site at Lohari. There were 31 students participant. We were all fascinated to witness this Buddhist monumental evidence in the vicinity of Wai City. We reached the foot of the hill, where a group of early Buddhist caves are located at 9.00 am by MSRTC Bus. From there we reached our destination at 9:45 am by a walk. There are eight excavations in the hill on the outskirts of the village just six kms north of the town of Wai, on the left bank of the Krishna. There is one *chaitya-grha* and remaining *viharas* belong to the late Hinayana period of Buddhism. The *chaitya* hall which contains a *stupa*, has since been converted into a *siva-linga*. The central figure may represent Buddha, added during the Mahayana occupation. Our visit to the Early Buddhist Cave site at Lohari was not only Historical but also a cultural as well. Though there are simple excavations, we realized that this is the sound proof of the spared of Buddhism in the vicinity of Wai City during the Early Historic Period.
