

## Action Taken Report (2022-23)

According to the feedback reports and as per the suggestions of stakeholders, following suggestions are given by IQAC:

1	Student	Syllabus was challenging (69.70% students reported).	The IQAC advised to all teachers to adopt different methodologies while teaching to make teaching and learning more interesting such as increase use of ICT tools, Roll Play, field visits etc.
