The Governance of the Institution:

1. The Management of Janata Shikshan Sanstha, Wai, cares for every stakeholder to ensure overall development of the college.
2. The Management organizes a Programme called “Gunagourav of the Students and Teachers” (Annual Appreciation Day) on the occasion of the Foundation Day (12th July) of Janata Shikshan Sanstha, Wai every year and felicitates meritorious students and best performing teachers.
3. The overall functioning of the college has been monitored through the College Development Committee (CDC) which is constituted of representatives from teaching, administrative staff, management, students, social workers, industrialists and educational experts.
4. The CDC has prepared a five-year (2019-2024) perspective development plan.
5. The CDC reviews academic results, infrastructure development, recruitment of faculty, budget, etc. and suggests quality enhancement of the teachers and students.

6. All the members of the faculty are given adequate freedom in performing their duties and responsibilities.
7. The faculty members and staff are given representation on different committees such as CDC, Purchase Committee, Student's Council, Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), etc, so as to gain their expertise in the decision making process of the institute.
8. Utmost care is taken that no student is deprived of higher education and it is ensured that all students get admission in the institution on the basis of merit.
9. Several activities are conducted in the institution to ensure overall development of the students such as sports, cultural, NSS, NCC, co-curricular and extra-curricular.
10. In addition to the above, a special section is established to provide special guidance and other facilities regarding several competitive examinations.
11. The institute mobilizes resources from the alumni, well-wishers and philanthropists in order to achieve the vision and mission of the institute.
