The following is the list of the Short Term Courses:

1. How to Write Application:

This course was conducted during the year2015-16 in collaboration with departments of English, Marathi and Hindi for the students of all three languages i.e. English, Marathi and Hindi. The syllabus of the course was formed. All members of all three languages taught in the course. Students learnt the skills of writing the application.

2. IT in Learning English:

Department of English has been conducting the short term course since 2016-17. The course is given to all the students of compulsory English of the classes B.A. III and B.Sc. III. They are given the training to open the Email ID in Outlook and Gmail. Students can send Email to the teacher regarding their requirement to learn various skills of English language.

3. Certificate Course in Social Science for Competitive Exams:

This course was conducted by the Departments of History, Political Science and Economics jointly during the year 2014-15 for the B.A.III (History, Political Science and Economics) students. In this course guidance was given for competitive Exams like MPSC, UPSC, and Civil Services, etc.

4. Certificate Course in History for Competitive Exams:

History occupies a significant place in competitive examinations like MPSC, UPSC Civil Services etc. Taking into consideration this need, the Department of History offers certificate course in History for Competitive Exams. This course imparts the knowledge of history which would be beneficial for their success.

5. Certificate Course in Political Science for Competitive Exams:

Department of Political Science conducts this course. Political Science is the most important subject for competitive exams such as UPSC, MPSC, NET, SET, Civil Services etc. This course encourages students to acquire the required knowledge of Political Science as a career.

6. Certificate Course in Personality Development:

From the academic year 2016-17 onwards, the Marathi Department organizes Personality Development Certificate course for the undergraduate students. The objective of this course is to improve soft-skills including verbal and written communication and to develop confidence in the students to face any interview.

7. Certificate Course in Land Record and Surveying (LRS)

Department of Geography conducts this course for the B.A.III (Geography) students. The course syllabus is framed locally in the department after the discussion with Syllabus Framing Committee. Syllabus will change from time to time. This is one year certificate course. Pattern of examination is annual. The eligibility for admission of the course is any admitted student of Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya, Wai. The basic objectives of the course are to acquaint the students with distinct dimensions of Land Record, to understand the land characteristics, to get information about distance and area and to make aware of Laws of Land and Property.

8. Certificate Course in Counselling and Life Skills Management:

The department of Psychology offers six-month part-time certificate course in counselling and Life Skills Management. It is self-designed and self-funding. The course was started after consultation with the renowned psychiatrists. This course provides primary training to students who wish to promote mental health in individuals, families, organizations and communities through careers in direct service, leadership, research and education.

9. Certificate Course in Practical Banking:

Department of Commerce runs a certificate course in Practical Banking. This course is being conducted for B.com III students. The object of the course is to give practical knowledge regarding banking transactions. This course is self-designed and self-funded. Apart from regular teaching in classroom, expert faculty from various banks are invited for guest lectures. The course is of immense use to net banking, cashless transactions, mobile banking etc.

10. Capsul Course in C++ Computer Programming:

Department of Physics and Mathematics jointly conduct this course. In this course, basic aspects of C++ programming language are taught. B.Sc. Part III Physics and Mathematics students are eligible for this course.

11. Certificate Course in Soil and Soil Testing:

Department of Chemistry runs this course. It is conducted for B.Sc. III (Chemistry) students. The college faculty in consultation with departmental experts havedesigned the syllabus of this course. This course gives the information and knowledge regarding soil, its composition and analysis to detect fertility of soil and various types of minerals present in the soil.

12. Certificate Course in Horticulture:

Department of Botany conducts this short-term course. It is self-funding and compulsory to B.Sc. III (Botany) students. The motto of the course is to create awareness regarding floriculture, fruit orchards, plant pathology and plant breeding techniques to student. Through the course, the department creates competent resource personnel who will propagate their knowledge at ground level and generate skillful persons at different villages in WaiTehasil.

13. Certificate Course in Sericulture:

Self-aided course in 'Sericulture' is conducted by Department of Zoology for B.sc part III (Zoology) students. The syllabus of the course is framed locally in the department with the oral consultancy of the experts of Sericulture Center, Wai. This course has been proved useful to create an awareness of the sericulture as a cottage industry among the students of rural area with farming background.

14.Certificate Course in M.S. Excel:

Department of Statistics conducts this course. This course is self-designed, self-funded and is conducted for B. Sc.I students. It is designed to give an introduction to basic spreadsheet tools and formulas so that students know the power of spreadsheets to map the data.

15. Certificate Course in R-Software:

This course is conducted by Department of Statistics for B.Sc. III (Statistics) students. Duration of the course is 4 months. The objectives of this course are to introduce statistical technology to the students, to get the knowledge for analysis of statistical data by using R-Software, to get job opportunities in the industrial sector and to develop skills for statistical consultancy.

16.Certificate Course in Library Management:

Library Department is conducting the said course from the academic year 2015-16. This course is run under the guidance of the Department of Lifelong and Extension, Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The duration of the course is 3 months. The eligibility for admission of the course is any admitted student of Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya, Wai. The objectives of the course are to introduce the library and information science to the students, to acquaint the library management and information to the students and to produce the qualitative librarians amongst the new students.

17. Certificate Course in Basic Beauty Culture:

Cultural Committee is conducting the said course from the academic year 2015-16. The duration of the course is 6 months. The eligibility for admission of the course is any admitted student of Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya, Wai. The objectives of the course are to create awareness about basic Beauty culture among students, to understand basic Beauty culture skills and to develop entrepreneurship skills in students.

18. Certificate Course in Fashion Designing:

Cultural Committee is conducting the said course from the academic year 2016-17. The duration of the course is 6 months. The eligibility for admission of the course is any admitted student of Kisan Veer Mahavidyalaya, Wai. The objectives of the course are create awareness about Fashion Designing among students, to develop Fashion Designingskills and to develop entrepreneurship skills in students.
