

## **Report**

### **(Initiatives taken to engage with and contribute to local community)**

The college has taken many initiatives to engage with and contribute to local community during the period of 2013-14 to 2017-18. The year wise report of the initiatives taken for the last five years is as follows:

#### **2013-14**

The surveys on 'Farmers' Problems of Village Khanapur' and 'Farmers' Problems of Village Pande' had been undertaken on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2014 to create socio-economic awareness. Twenty one students made their house to house interactions with the villagers.

#### **2014-15**

The surveys on 'Consumers Problems in Wai Weekly Market' and 'Traders Problems in Wai Weekly Market' had been undertaken on 15<sup>th</sup> September 2014 to address market related problems. Twenty two students made their face to face interactions with the consumers and traders.

#### **2015-16**

Visits to 'Mapro Food Product, Shendurjane', 'Marathi Vishwakosh Karyalaya' Wai and 'Aquatic Eco System- Dhom Reservoir' had been made on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2015, 27<sup>th</sup> October 2015 and 12<sup>th</sup> February 2016 to focus on 'Demand & Quality of Local Resources', 'the process of formation of Marathi encyclopedia' and 'Water Life and its Preservation' respectively. Accordingly Twenty three, twenty five and seventy five participants made their contribution. The surveys on 'Problems of Hilly Area Dwellers: Village Taighat' had been completed on 12<sup>th</sup> January 2016 to focus on Socio-economic condition and life style of the villagers and the condition of tourist satisfaction. Forty one participants made these activities successful.

#### **2016-17**


The excursion tours to Kashad been arranged on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2016 and 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2017 to observe and study rare plants and flowers and make an awareness of biodiversity hotspot zone. Twenty nine and twenty students along with the teachers participated in them respectively. The visits to Raireswar on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2016 and to Agriculture Exhibition, Bhuinj on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2017 had also been arranged to observe the condition of local historical place and to observe agricultural products respectively. Sixty nine and twenty two students along with the teachers participated in these activities accordingly. The attempt of survey on 'Problems of Pidmont

Village: Lohare' had been made on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2017 to find out the real condition and life style of village people. Twenty eight students made this survey successful.

**2017-18**

Visits to Historical Monument –Menvali was arranged on 19<sup>th</sup>December 2017 to observe the condition of historical place. Thirty two and thirty seven students made their participation in these activities. The survey on 'Population of Menavali village' had been undertaken on 19<sup>th</sup> December 2017 to find out the effect of population. Thirty two students had completed this activity. The excursion tour to Kashad been arranged on 22<sup>nd</sup>September 2017 to make an awareness of biodiversity hotspot zone. Twenty students along with the teachers participated in it.Lecture series on 'Awareness of Mental Health' were arranged from 9<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>October 2017 to make an awareness of how to be mentally fit.
