Report

The activities conducted for promotion of universal values (Truth, Righteous Conduct, Love, Non-Violence and Peace), national values, human values, national integration, communal harmony and social cohesion as well as for observance of fundamental duties had been organized from 2013-14 to 2017-18. The year wise report of these activities is as follows:

2013-14:
