- Soft copy should be submitted in A4 Size Paper with Microsoft Word format using Times New Roman font size 12 for English version and 14 Unicode for Marathi and Hindi versions.
- Title of the Paper/Sub-title: 14 pts centered
- Name of the Author, Institute/Organization Address
- Abstract: Maximum 150 words, 10 pts. italics and aligned on both sides and 5 Keywords

- References: please use APA style for references
- Maximum permitted length is 1500 to 2000 words
- The manuscript will be reviewed rigorously by the reviewers as per the ethical rules of publication by the Journal
- The research papers will be published in "Aayushi International Interdisciplinary Research Journal" (Impact Factor 8.379)
